

W-HFB Recognition at IFB Annual Meeting

The Warren-Henderson Farm Bureau® was recognized for its achievements during the 105th Annual Meeting in Chicago. W-HFB received the following program/committee awards: Gold in Membership Quota and Women's Committee; Silver in Legislative/Political Process, Young Leaders, and Foundation; and Bronze in Ag Literacy, Commodities & Marketing, Local Affairs, Communication & Promotion, Member Relations, and Multi-County. Additionally, W-HFB received a certificate for a Local Affairs Most Outstanding Project for the Cultivating Community Breakfast held last June. Along with breakfast, information on the topics of Animal Health, Pesticide Application, and Ethanol were displayed. A grain entrapment and dust explosion demonstration were also part of the summer event.
