

Annual Tractor Drive Set for June 4th

Saturday, June 4, 2022 has been set as the date for a *Maple City Antique Tractor Association* Tractor Drive. The Maple City Antique Tractor Association is generously sponsoring this June Tractor Drive as a fundraiser for the Warren-Henderson Farm Bureau Foundation Scholarship and Ag Education Partnership's Ag in the Classroom programs. All makes and models of tractors are welcomed (your tractor must be able to maintain a speed of 12MPH).

The 60-mile tractor cruise will begin at 907 N. Monroe St., Abingdon at 8:30am and cruise through the scenic hills and farms of Knox County. The ride will consist of both hard surfaced and gravel roads, passing through Wolf Covered Bridge on to Knoxville. Lunch will be held at Big Catz BBQ in Knoxville. The return portion of the trip will cover more of Knoxville and the Lake Bracken Community, before the group heads back to Abingdon.

A \$25 entry fee will be required for all tractors, with these proceeds going toward the Scholarship and Ag in the Classroom programs. Checks should be made out to W-HFB Foundation.
